Preparedness Month Initiative





Prohibited Vegetation In Napa

Prohibited Vegetation

Napa County Code section 8.36.030 defines a list of pyrophytic plant species that should not be planted within 30 feet of structures.

Pyrophytic species are fire-prone vegetation that is adapted to or fuels rapid burning, high heat output, and ember creation. Those species include but are not limited to:

- Shrubs
 - Chamise, Greasewood, Coyote Brush, Giant Chinquapin, California Buckwheat, Chaparral Pea, Scrub Oak, Black Sage, Huckleberry.
- Trees
 - o Coulter Pine, Knobcone Pine, Monterey Pine
- · Ecological Weeds
 - Acacia, Jubata Grass, Pampas Grass, Scotch Broom, French Broom, Eucalyptus, Fountain Grass, Grose
- Exotic Plants
 - Firs, Cedars, False Cypress, Larch, Japanese
 Honeysuckle, Palm, Spruces, Pines, Arborvitae, Hemlock




