I have lived in Napa County for approximately six years and intend to remain here for the remainder of my career. During this time, I have worked in the Office of the Public Defender as a Deputy Public Defender. While, regrettably, I did not have an interest in planning for my long term financial future prior to moving to Napa, I now consider it a priority. This interest developed as several of my best friends are financial planners in a variety of capacities. While explaining my situation to them, it became apparent to me how valuable and important a resource the Deferred Compensation benefit is. As an active learner, I began to engage in individual study of the program, and also initiated conversations with a variety of county employees. With some employees who are less familiar with the program, the conversations gave me an opportunity to espouse the programs benefits. With those more familiar with the program, it provided the opportunity to ask questions and continue to develop my understanding. I do not have a formal education in investment or financial planning, and for this Board I consider that to be an asset. Over time, I have developed a sense of the importance of this benefit, the importance of educating people on this benefit when appropriate, and studying the variety of offerings to develop an effective portfolio for myself. I contribute the maximum possible amount to the 457 program and I expect this practice to continue until my retirement. I can offer the perspective of someone who has a sense of the strengths and weaknesses of the program and its offerings, not through the prism of a formal education, but the prism of one who comes from the same place as the majority of the workers in this county, and I very much wish to effectively advocate for the program and offerings that can optimally benefit the employees of my home county.
