<p>Other Relevant Information:</p> <p>Based on the EPA’s Air quality index report, Napa County comes in fourth in the Bay area for number of days with an AQI greater than 151. Napa County is presently under a state of emergency due to the severe drought across the County. Due to the drought and other factors, it is to be expected that Napa County may experience an extremely active fire season in 2022 and over the next several years. This will significantly increase the need for clean air facilities for Napa County residents.</p>
