

**NAPA COUNTY AGREEMENT NO. 170216B
AMENDMENT NO. 3**

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 3 TO AGREEMENT NO. 170216B is made and entered into as of this _____ day of _____, 2022, by and between NAPA COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as “COUNTY”, and **JOHNSON CONTROL FIRE PROTECTION**, a Limited Partnership, whose business address is 4700 Exchange Ct, Suite 300, Boca Raton, FL 33431 hereinafter referred to as “CONTRACTOR”;

RECITALS

WHEREAS, COUNTY and Tyco Fire & Security Management, Inc. doing business as SimplexGrinnell (“Tyco”) entered into Agreement No. 170216B as of August 9, 2016 and (hereafter referred to as “Agreement”), whereby SimplexGrinnell agreed to provide preventative maintenance and inspection for the fire sprinklers located in COUNTY owned or operated buildings as authorized by Government Code section 31000; and

WHEREAS, in September 2016, Tyco merged with Johnson Controls to become Johnson Control Fire Protection; and

WHEREAS, on October 20, 2020, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR entered into Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement to update the scope of work, to add additional facilities including the Napa County Airport and the Re-entry Facility, and to increase maximum compensation to accommodate the revised scope and the need for additional non-routine services, including 5-year inspections and needed fire system repairs; and

WHEREAS, on May 4, 2021, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR entered into Amendment No. 2 to extend the term for an additional two years through June 30, 2023, to update the scope of work, and to increase maximum compensation to accommodate the need for additional non-routine services, including 5-year inspections and needed fire system repairs and an increase in rates for routine and non-routine services for the fire sprinklers located in County owned or operated buildings; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR now wish to amend the agreement to update the scope of work and to increase maximum compensation to accommodate the need for additional routine services, including kitchen hood inspection, testing and cleaning services located in County owned or operated buildings.

TERMS

NOW, THEREFORE, the Agreement is amended as follows:

1. Exhibit "A", "A-1" and "A-2", "B", "B-1" and "B-2" of the Agreement is rescinded and replaced in full by that document entitled Exhibit "A-3" and "B-3", and all references in the Agreement to Exhibit "A", "A-1" and "A-2", "B", "B-1" and "B-2" shall mean Exhibit "A-3" and "B-3", respectively.

2. Paragraph 2 is hereby amended to read in full as follows:

2. **Scope of Services.** CONTRACTOR shall provide COUNTY those services set forth in Exhibit "A-3", attached hereto.

3. Paragraph 3 is hereby amended to read in full as follows:

3. **Compensation.**

(a) Rates. In consideration of CONTRACTOR's fulfillment of the promised work, COUNTY shall pay CONTRACTOR at the rates set forth in Exhibit "B-3", attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein.

(b) Expenses. No travel or other expenses will be reimbursed by COUNTY.

(c) Maximum Amount. Notwithstanding subparagraphs (a) and (b), the maximum payments under this Agreement shall be a total of SIXTY FIVE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED AND THIRTY THREE DOLLARS (\$65,333) for routine professional services per fiscal year and NINETY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$90,000) for authorized non-routine testing, including 5 year inspections, maintenance, repair and emergency services per fiscal year as requested by the County's Director of Public Works or designee; provided, however, that such amounts shall not be construed as guaranteed sums, and compensation shall be based upon services actually rendered.

4. **Counterparts.** This Amendment No. 3 may be executed in counterparts, which when taken together, shall constitute a single signed original as though all parties had executed the same page.

5. **Electronic Signatures.** This Amendment No. 3 may be executed by electronic signature(s) and transmitted in a portable document format ("PDF") version by email and such electronic signature(s) shall be deemed original for purposes of this Amendment No. 3 and shall have the same force and effect as a manually executed original.

6. This Amendment No. 3 shall be effective as of the date first written above.

7. This Amendment No. 3 represents all the changes to the Agreement and prior amendments agreed to by Licensor and Licensee. No enforceable oral representations or other agreements have been made by the parties except as specifically stated herein. All other provisions of the Agreement and prior amendments not addressed in Amendment No. 3 shall remain in full force and effect.

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8. Except as provided in 1 through 7 above, the terms and provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.



SCOPE OF WORK

CONTRACTOR shall provide COUNTY with the following services:

I. DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES

CONTRACTOR shall provide COUNTY with three **Quarterly** and one **Annual** (doubles as the fourth quarterly for all equipment) inspection and testing at the following locations. Inspection and testing shall conform to the standards established by the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA 25). Unless otherwise indicated, all locations are in Napa, California.

Written Reports: A written report, utilizing the forms established by the NFPA, shall be provided for each inspection and test at each location. Reports are due to the Napa County Maintenance Supervisor within five (5) working days of test/service.

Hours and Frequency of Service: All inspections and testing will be performed between the hours of 7:30am and 4:00pm Monday through Friday, excluding holidays.

Non Routine and Emergency Services:

CONTRACTOR shall provide the COUNTY with authorized non-routine testing, which includes 5-year inspections, maintenance, repair services and emergency services for all fire sprinkler and kitchen hood systems as requested by the County’s Director of Public Works or designee at the hourly rates and call out timing provided in Exhibit B.

Minimum Certifications and Licensing:

A California C16 Fire Protection Contractor’s License is required. Registration with the California Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) is required and a valid DIR registration number must be maintained throughout the entirety of the contract.

II. COMPLIANCE WITH GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 7550. As required by Government Code section 7550, each document or report prepared by CONTRACTOR for or under the direction of COUNTY pursuant to this Agreement shall contain the numbers and dollar amounts of the Agreement and all subcontracts under the Agreement relating to the preparation of the document or written report. The Agreement and subcontract dollar amounts shall be

contained in a separate section of the document or written report. If multiple documents or written reports are the subject of the Agreement or subcontracts, the disclosure section may also contain a statement indicating that the total contract amount represents compensation for multiple documents or written reports.

1. Normal service hours are 7:30 AM to 4:30 P.M., Monday - Friday, excluding holidays.
2. No travel or other expenses will be reimbursed by COUNTY. Travel time will be charged as follows:
 - a. There is no travel time charge within 60 minutes drive time enroute to the service call.

- b. Travel time shall apply only if drive time exceeds 60 minutes to the customer site.
- 3. All emergency service call rates apply based on normal working hours; i.e. if call is placed at 6:30 a.m. then 6:30-7:30 a.m. is overtime. Work continuing past 7:30 a.m. is charged at normal rates until 4:30 p.m.
 - a. Service calls dispatched after 4PM on normal business days, weekends, and holidays shall be Portal to Portal.
 - b. Over Time rates apply outside of normal service hours and Saturdays.
 - c. Double Time applies for holidays and Sundays.
- 4. Normal working hours service call minimum charge is:
 - a. Alarm & Detection Hardwire: \$747.00 After Hours Call: \$1065.00
 - b. Alarm & Detection Software: \$747.00 After Hours Call: \$1065.00
 - c. Sprinkler: \$561.00 After Hours Call: \$786.00
 - d. Inspection / Suppression: \$555.00 After Hours Call: \$780.00
- 5. Engineering, design and permit fees include time spent surveying project, meeting with AHJ officials to pull permits, and other related duties.

Payment of California Prevailing Wage is required.

MAXIMUM ANNUAL PAYMENTS UNDER THIS AGREEMENT

The annual maximum payment allowed under this contract to the CONTRACTOR is ONE HUNDRED FIFTY FIVE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED AND THIRTY THREE DOLLARS (\$155,333) for professional services per fiscal year.
