

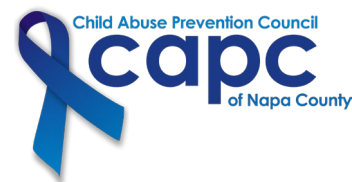

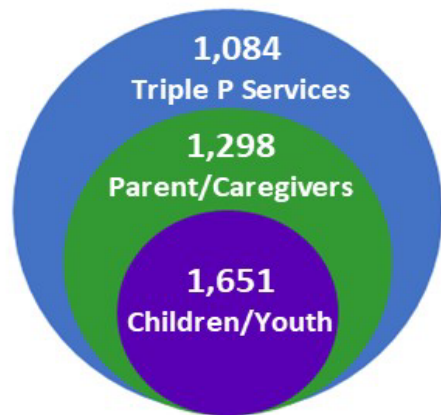

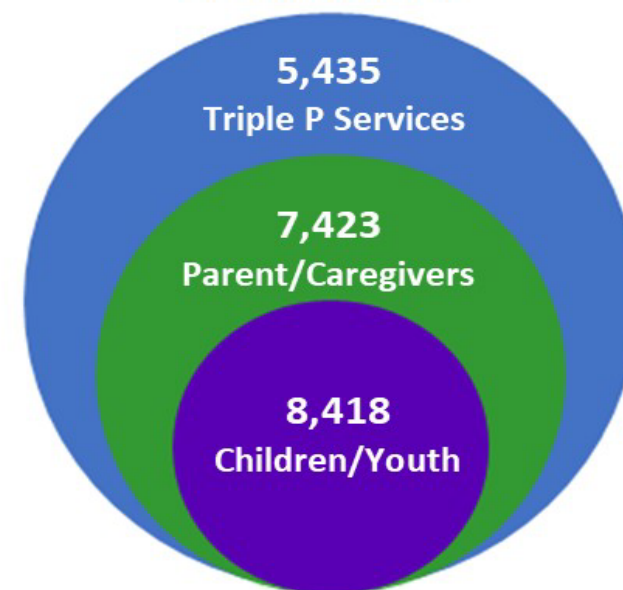

Cumulative Data



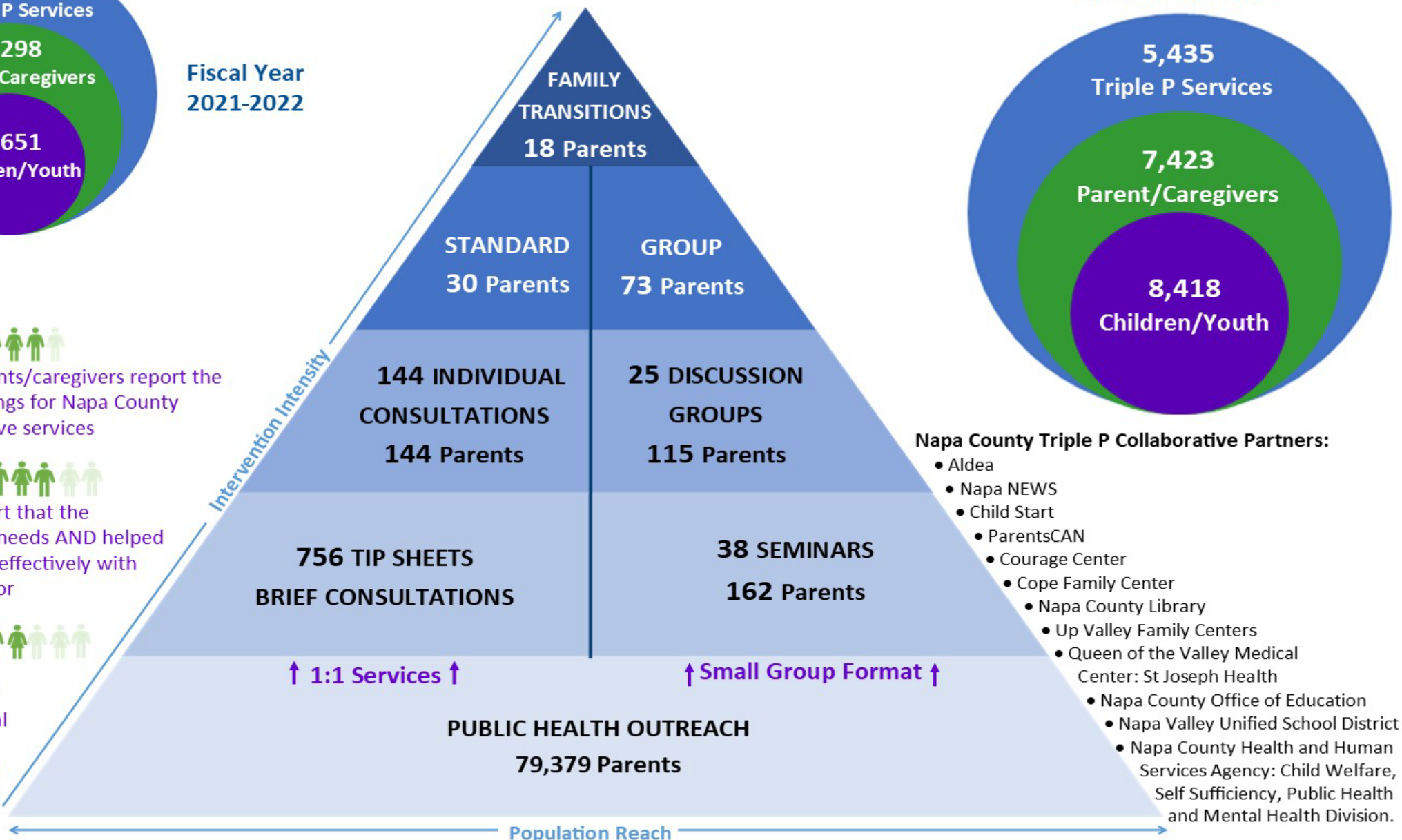

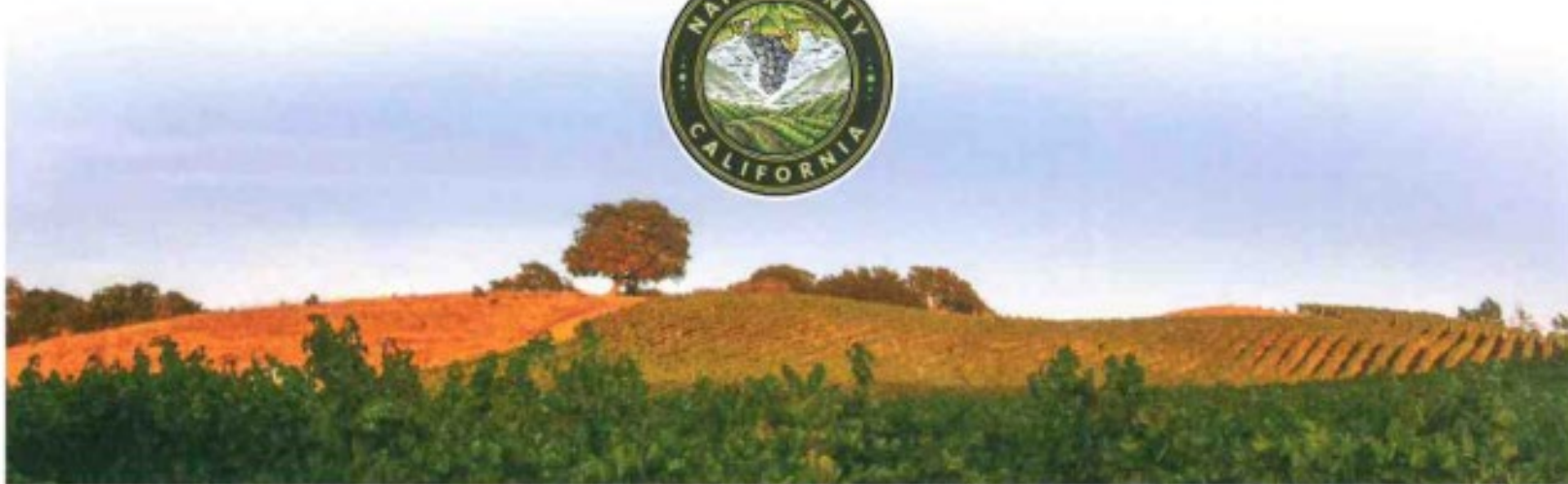

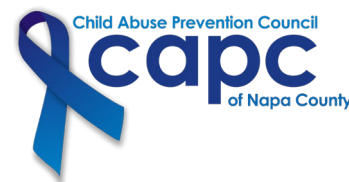
