Dear County Board of Supervisors,

We, the undersigned homeowners of La Tierra Drive in Angwin, write this letter in strong support of the County of Napa accepting the Public Utility Easement over La Tierra Drive, which will allow PG&E a right of way to install underground power lines under our shared street.

When we were first alerted to the proposed placing of our high voltage power lines underground, we held discussions and determined that all nine homeowners on our street support this project. There were two prominent reasons for our support. First, our portion of the Angwin community has seen a dramatic increase in power outages in the past few years. Storm activity hits the Angwin area particularly hard, and many of the outages now last for multiple days.

The second reason for our support being so strong is the risk of fire danger due to overhead high voltage lines. Our street is surrounded by high voltage lines, increasing the odds that a hot line could ignite our subdivision. The October 2020 Glass Fire came within several hundred yards of our subdivision. In our annual water meeting last month, we discussed our commitment as neighbors to follow the Napa Firewise guidelines creating defensible spaces surrounding our homes. The implementation of undergrounding our high voltage lines will provide peace of mind and improved risk ratings by home insurance companies.

We respectfully request that your board accepts the dedicated Public Utility Easement that was previously dedicated to Napa County when the subdivision was built in 1965. Your acceptance will allow the undergrounding to proceed in 2025, improving our community that loves living in Angwin.
