28 I, Glenn Schreuder, declare as follows:

9 8. After we packed up our two vehicles, we could begin to see the glow of the fire in  
10 Soda Canyon below us, through which the only escape route – Soda Canyon Road – runs.  
11 Accordingly, we drove up Soda Canyon Road towards Foss Valley (and towards the Mountain  
12 Peak Winery proposed location at the 6.1 mile mark of Soda Canyon Road) to Antica Winery at  
13 the very end of the paved portion of Soda Canyon Road (located at approximately the 6.75 mile  
14 mark of Soda Canyon Road). Fortunately, somebody had already opened the large steel gates at  
15 the entrance of Antica Winery and we were able to seek temporary shelter in the vineyards. Later  
16 than night, while at Antica, I observed a horizontal tornado of fire travelling against the 60+  
17 gusting winds on the western face of the mountain range heading west-northwest in the direction  
18 of our home. [REDACTED]


21 9. Later that evening, using a light I had with me that had a strobe function, I was  
22 able to flag down a CHP helicopter that was circling the area warning residents to evacuate.  
23 Other residents eventually made their way to where we were located in the vineyards of Antica  
24 Winery and this location then became an unofficial pick-up point for approximately 45 residents  
25 throughout that fateful night.

26 10. Using night vision goggles, the CHP helicopter pilot was able to land nearby in an  
27 area that was in close proximity to high voltage power lines. This in and of itself was  
28 unbelievable due to the 60+ mile per hour crosswinds that the pilot was dealing with. My wife,

1 Judy Schreuder and I, along two of our neighbors, Anne Palotas and Meah Muzquiz, were  
2 evacuated in the CHP helicopter, an experience which was both incredible and terrifying. Once  
3 off the ground, the sight of the fire below us was truly unbelievable. As we flew over the Atlas  
4 Peak area, we could see flames everywhere and scores of brightly glowing orange objects on the  
5 grounds which were obviously homes, barns and other structures fully ablaze. Given that Atlas  
6 Peak Road was similar to Soda Canyon Road in that it's a long, narrow, winding dead-end road, I  
7 assumed there would be lives lost due to lack of fast, safe egress. Unfortunately, that  
8 assumption proved to be accurate.
