28 I, Shelle Wolfe, declare as follows:

Declaration of Shelle Wolfe

1 north from the paved portion of Soda Canyon Road and goes for approximately eight (8) miles
2 to other homes and vineyards) towards my house and the paved portion of Soda Canyon Road.
3 On information and belief, the cars contained vineyard workers who were picking grapes at
4 vineyards accessible only by the dirt road and the workers were seeking to escape the fire.

12 10. From my home, which sits in what is called Foss Valley near the top of Atlas Peak,
13 it is an approximately one (1) mile drive to reach the crest of Soda Canyon at about the 5.0 mile-
14 mark on Soda Canyon Road. From the “crest,” one can see the Soda Canyon in its entirety and
15 all the way to San Francisco on a clear day.

16 11. When we came to the crest of the hill that looks down the other side of Soda
17 Canyon, the canyon was completely engulfed in flames. It can only be described as a firestorm,
18 with howling winds, tornadoes of flames cascading down the sides of the canyon, and embers
19 flying everywhere.


7 15. As we entered into the “belly” of Soda Canyon, the body of my car started to heat
8 up considerably from the flames as we drove through. There was fire on both sides of the road
9 and leaping over the car. At one point, around the 1.5 mile-mark, just before Loma Vista Drive,
10 we had to drive around a huge tree lying across the road that was completely engulfed in flames.
11 During our escape, we did not see any other cars, firetrucks or police vehicles. On information
12 and belief, we were the last residents/property owners in vehicles to successfully escape from
13 Soda Canyon Road that night.


