

**AMENDMENT NO. 1  
NAPA COUNTY AGREEMENT NO. 200152B**

**THIS AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO AGREEMENT NO. 200152B** is effective as of this \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2022, by and between NAPA COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY," and THE SALVATION ARMY, a California non-profit religious corporation, whose business address is 3048 Hawthorne Boulevard, Rancho Palos Verdes, CA 90275, hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR."

**RECITALS**

**WHEREAS**, COUNTY wishes to obtain specialized services, as authorized by Government Code section 31000, in order to provide a daily meal for the residents of the Napa County Homeless Shelter; and

**WHEREAS**, CONTRACTOR is willing to provide such specialized services to COUNTY under the terms and conditions set forth herein.

**WHEREAS**, the parties wish to adjust the compensation and amend the terms of the Agreement accordingly.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR hereby amend the Agreement in the manner set forth below.

**TERMS**

- 1) Paragraph 3 of the Agreement, entitled "Compensation" is amended to read in full as follows:

**"Compensation.**

- (a) Rates. In consideration of CONTRACTOR's fulfillment of the promised work, COUNTY shall pay CONTRACTOR at the rate of EIGHT DOLLARS (\$8.00) per meal provided.
- (b) Expenses. No travel or other expenses will be reimbursed by COUNTY.
- (c) Maximum Amount. Notwithstanding subparagraphs (a) and (b), the maximum payments under this Agreement shall be a total of ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000) for professional services per fiscal year; provided, however, that such amounts shall not be construed as guaranteed sums, and compensation shall be based upon services actually rendered and reimbursable expenses actually incurred."

- 2) All other terms and conditions of the Agreement, except as amended herein, shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
