

COUNTY CLERK/RECORDER

- 8/31/82 The County Clerk is authorized to make payment for polling places. Fees established in Fees-Rentals Section of the Policy Manual.
- 4/17/84 Procedure for checks to be conducted by three persons serving as the Logic and Accuracy Board in connection with elections
- On the Monday before each election, the election program will be read through the computer, and a printout will be checked against the ballots for accuracy.
- Logic and Accuracy test cards will be read through the computer, and the printout will be checked for accuracy of votes cast in this tally procedure and a printed master test will be created.
- On election night, the Logic and Accuracy test cards will be read through the computer, and the printout will be checked against the master test.
- 11/21/89 All non-judicial duties of the County Clerk were combined with the County Recorder, effective December 9, 1989, creating a County Clerk/Recorder function.
- 9/30/97 Precinct worker pay was increased from \$54.00 per day to \$80.00 per day for Judges and Clerks and from \$59.00 per day to \$100.00 per day for Inspectors.
