

NAPA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 25-___

**RATIFICATION OF THE PROCLAMATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY
ISSUED IN RESPONSE TO THE PICKETT FIRE**

WHEREAS, Government Code section 8630 and Napa County Code section 2.80.060, subd. (A)(2), authorize and empower the Napa County Executive Officer acting as the Director of Emergency Services to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency when the County is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity and the Board is not in session, subject to confirmation by the Board within seven (7) days; and

WHEREAS, on August 24, 2025, the County Executive Officer acting as the Director of Emergency Services issued a Proclamation of Local Emergency in Napa County, for those reasons set forth above, and in the proclamation attached as Exhibit “A.”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Napa County Board of Supervisors that:

1. The Board of Supervisors hereby confirms the finding of the Napa County Executive Officer that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property arose within Napa County on August 24, 2025, due to the Pickett Fire and the need to treat those affected, that such conditions continue to exist, and that such conditions warranted and continue to warrant a proclamation of local emergency.
2. The Board hereby ratifies the proclamation attached as Exhibit “A” to this resolution and hereby finds a local emergency continues to exist throughout Napa County as a result of the Pickett Fire.
3. During the existence of this local emergency all orders instituted by the Napa County Executive Officer as the Director of Emergency Services shall remain in place as orders of the Board of Supervisors.
4. Until the local emergency is terminated the powers, functions, and duties of the Napa County Executive Officer/Director of Emergency Services and the emergency organization of Napa County shall be those prescribed by State law and the ordinances, resolutions, and approved emergency services plans of Napa County.
5. The Board hereby requests that the Governor grant assistance under the California Disaster Assistance Act and the State Private Nonprofit Organizations Assistance Program to the County and eligible community members and businesses to the fullest extent possible. This Board further requests the Governor to request the President of the United States to make all relevant funds available to the County and all eligible community members and businesses, including but not limited to, federal aid for individual assistance and public assistance, and aid provided by the Small Business Administration. The County Executive Officer is directed to forward a copy of this resolution through the State Director of the Office of Emergency Services to the Governor of California.

6. The County Executive Officer or designee is hereby ordered and directed to give this Resolution and the proclamations and orders contained therein widespread publicity and notice.
7. This confirmation of the proclamation of local emergency shall be reviewed by the Board of Supervisors at least every 60 days until terminated, to determine the need for continuing the local emergency, and termination of the local emergency shall be proclaimed by this Board at the earliest possible date that conditions warrant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the State Director of Emergency Services and the Governor.
