**WHEREAS**, 2025 marks the 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary of National Public Health Week; and

**WHEREAS**, the theme for National Public Health Week in 2025 is "It Starts Here"; and

**WHEREAS**, highlighting all areas of public health, priority areas of National Public Health Week 2025 are individual and community health, climate action, health equity, advocacy, and strengthening the public health workforce; and
