**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF NAPA COUNTY,
STATE OF CALIFORNIA, INCREASING FEES FOR AGRICULTURAL
COMMISSIONER/SEALER OF WEIGHTS AND MEASURES AMENDING
PART 20 (AGRICULTURAL COMMISSIONER/SEALER OF WEIGHTS
AND MEASURES) OF SECTION III OF THE NAPA COUNTY BOARD
POLICY MANUAL**

WHEREAS, there is a need to increase the fees charged by the Napa County to recover the costs of services provided by the Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer of Weights Measures to amend Part 20 (Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer of Weights and Measures) of Section III of the Napa County Board Policy Manual; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Food & Agriculture - Division of Measurement & Standards increased the device registration administrative fee effective April 28, 2021; and

WHEREAS, at least ten days prior to the date of this Resolution, data was available to the public regarding fees identified in Government Code Section 66016(d) indicating the amount of cost, or estimated cost, required to provide the service for which required fees or service charges are levied and the revenue sources anticipated to provide the service, including general fund revenues; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 66016, at least 14 days prior to the date of this Resolution, notice was mailed to any persons who had requested same; and

WHEREAS, notice of the hearing of the proposed fee was published twice in the manner set forth in Section 6062a as required by Section 66018, subdivision (a), of the Government Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Napa as follows:

1. The Board hereby establishes, increases, or otherwise modifies those fees shown as added (by underlining) or deleted (by strike-out) on Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein;
2. The Board hereby directs the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the Napa County to integrate the changes approved above into Section III of the Board Policy Manual, "Fees for Services Provided by County Departments and Agencies" in the manner set forth in Exhibit "B," attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein;
3. The Board finds this Resolution is statutorily exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Title 14, California Code of Regulations, Section 15273(a)(1) and (2).
