

RESOLUTION NO. 91-91

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY
OF NAPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING FUNDS INTO
WHICH CERTAIN PENALTIES IMPOSED IN CRIMINAL CASES
SHALL BE DEPOSITED.

WHEREAS, Government Code section 76000 provides that there shall be levied in each county an additional penalty of \$7.00 for every \$10.00 or fraction thereof which shall be collected together with and in the same manner as the amounts established by section 1464 of the Penal Code upon every fine, penalty or forfeiture imposed and collected by the courts for criminal offenses, including all offenses involving a violation of the Vehicle Code or any local ordinance adopted pursuant to the Vehicle Code, except parking offenses subject to Article 3 (commencing with section 40200) of Chapter 1 of Division 17 of the Vehicle Code; and

WHEREAS, these moneys shall be taken from fines and forfeitures deposited with the County Treasurer prior to any division pursuant to section 1463 of the Penal Code; and

WHEREAS, such amounts may be deposited in any of five (5) different funds in the discretion in the Board of Supervisors, except that the amount deposited in the Emergency Medical Services Fund shall be the same as that deposited prior to June 1, 1991, in accordance with a resolution adopted by the Board of Supervisors prior to that date.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved by the Board of Supervisors as follows:

1. There is hereby established in the Napa County Treasury an Emergency Medical Services Fund pursuant to Government Code section 76104. Two Dollars (\$2.00) of every Seven Dollars (\$7.00) as described in Government Code section 76000(a) shall be deposited into the Fund. The Fund may only be used to support Emergency Medical Services in accordance with Chapter 2.5 (commencing with section 1798.98(a)) of Division 2.5 of the Health and Safety Code.

2. There is hereby established in the Napa County Treasury a Courthouse Construction Fund pursuant to Government Code section 76100. Four Dollars (\$4.00) of every Seven Dollars (\$7.00) as described in Government Code section 76000(a) shall be deposited into the Fund. The fund may only be used to rehabilitate existing courtrooms or an existing courtroom building or buildings for other uses if a new courtroom or a courtroom building or buildings are acquired, constructed, or financed, or to acquire, rehabilitate, construct, or finance excess courtrooms or an excess courtroom building or buildings if that excess is anticipated to be needed at a later time.

3. There is hereby established in the Napa County Treasury a Criminal Justice Facilities Construction Fund pursuant to Government Code §76101. One Dollar (\$1.00) of every Seven Dollars (\$7.00) as described in Government Code section 76000(a) shall be deposited into the Fund. The Fund may only be used for improvement of criminal justice automated information systems, and for the construction, reconstruction, expansion, improvement, operation, or maintenance of jails, women's centers, detention facilities, juvenile halls, and courtrooms.

4. The County Treasurer shall hold the moneys in the Funds described above separate from any funds subject to transfer or division pursuant to section 1463 of the Penal Code.

5. Except as hereafter provided, this resolution supersedes all prior resolutions and ordinances, if any, on the same subject; provided that the funds established by the Board of Supervisors based on predecessors to the statutes referred to herein, such as Fund 106 and Fund 105, shall continue to exist and be used for the purposes for which they were established.

The foregoing resolution was duly and regularly adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Napa, State of California, at a regular meeting of said Board held on the 20th day of August, 1991, by the following vote:
