Responsible for farming the 87 acre hillside estate vineyard on Spring Mountain. Make all farming decisions and report directly to the general manager. Direct all farming operations including pruning, irrigation, fertilization, spraying, suckering, petiole sampling, canopy management, crop thinning, pest control, weed control, erosion control, berry sampling and harvest. Responsible for payroll, hiring and firing, safety, record keeping, and compliance with local and state laws. Manage the non-vineyard property, including maintaining roads and water supply and preventing erosion. Emphasize farming for wine quality and farming for the longevity of the vineyard. Special areas of focus include:

-Sustainable Farming

Maintain a full time, permanent crew. Farm organically with emphasis on sustainability and farm 20 acres biodynamically. Utilize IPM methods including beneficial insect releases, raptor roosts, close vine monitoring and promote biodiversity with chickens, bees, and cover crops. Assisted in certifying the Cain Vineyard with Fish Friendly Farming.

-Vineyard Development

Directed or assisted in the redevelopment of over half the estate during my time at Cain. Collaborated on decisions and directed implementation of vineyard design, land preparation, plant material acquisition, and irrigation design.

-Financial Management

Create yearly expense budget and analyze year end costs. Over the past six years have cut vineyard costs by half, mostly by reducing waste and increasing efficiency.

Regularly visit the outside vineyards and work with growers to produce high quality fruit. Evaluate current and potential vineyards and work with growers and winemakers to determine harvest date.
