Subject: Request for Public Comment on Proposal to Establish “No Parking/Tow Away” zones on Sunnyside Road between Sanitarium Road and Hillcrest Road

Dear Community Member:

The Department of Public Works has received several complaints from Property Owners/Residents and the California Highway Patrol as well as the Napa County Fire Department Offices concerning vehicles parking on both sides of Sunnyside Avenue between Sanitarium Road and Hillcrest Road. This is causing potentially hazardous road conditions by limiting access for emergency vehicles. Sunnyside Road is a narrow, winding local residential roadway with very limited shoulders available.

The Department of Public Works in consultation with the California Highway Patrol is proposing to establish permanent **“No Parking/Tow Away” Zones on both sides of Sunnyside Road between Sanitarium Road and Hillcrest Road.** However, before going to the Board of Supervisors for their review, we would like the input of the immediate community around Sunnyside Road. Please provide any comments in writing through mail or email (preferred) by the end of business day on **January 5, 2022.**

The Department of Public Works, California Highway Patrol and Napa County Fire Department will finalize this proposal after receipt of community/stakeholders input.
