**RESOLUTION OF THE NAPA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
ESTABLISHING NO PARKING – TOW AWAY ZONES ALONG
SUNNYSIDE ROAD BETWEEN SANITARIUM ROAD AND HILLCREST
ROAD**

WHEREAS, Section 22507 of the California Vehicle Code authorizes a local authority to prohibit the parking of vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Section 22651(n) of the California Vehicle Code authorizes a local authority to remove parked vehicles from restricted parking areas designated as a tow away zone; and

WHEREAS, Napa County seeks to ensure a safe and efficient road network; and

WHEREAS, certain county roadways have been determined by an engineering study to require such regulation.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Napa County Board of Supervisors as follows:

1. Pursuant to Section 22507 and 22651(n) of the California Vehicle Code, the parking of vehicles be prohibited at the following location and any vehicles parked in the following locations shall be subject to tow:
 - Both sides of Sunnyside Road between Sanitarium Road and Hillcrest Road (as depicted on Exhibit A).
2. The Road Commissioner is directed to install appropriate signage in furtherance of this resolution and in conformance with the Vehicle Code, including but not limited to Section 22651(n).
