**RESOLUTION OF THE NAPA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS,
STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AMENDING COUNTY POLICY MANUAL
PART I: SECTION 37F, BILINGUAL PAY DIFFERENTIAL POLICY,
EFFECTIVE APRIL 19, 2022**

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 25300 provides that the Board of Supervisors shall provide for the number, compensation, tenure, appointment and conditions of employment of county employees and that such action may be taken by ordinance or resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Human Resources recommends that the County make changes to the Bilingual Differential Pay Policy, County Policy Manual Part I: Section 37F, as set forth in Exhibit "A."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Napa County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the changes to the Bilingual Differential Pay Policy, as set forth in Exhibit "A," effective April 19, 2022.
