- Approximately 28% of the county's population is 60+ years of age; more than 1 in 4 residents.



Napa County Projected Population Change by Age Group



ADULT PROTECTIVE SERVICES (APS)

 Provides voluntary services to ensure the safety and wellbeing of elders (60 years and older) and dependent adults (18-59 years) who are in danger of being mistreated or neglected, are unable to take care of themselves or protect themselves from harm, and

have no one to assist them.

• Ave. 72 open/active cases per month

IN HOME SUPPORTIVE SERVICES (IHSS)

• Assists eligible low income aged, blind, and disabled persons, who are at risk for out-of-home placement, to remain safely at home by authorizing payment for care provider services. Care providers can be a relative or other person of the care

recipient's choosing.

• Ave. 1,330 active cases per month

IHSS PUBLIC AUTHORITY

• Works in conjunction with IHSS to establish and maintain a Registry of screened care providers that can be accessed by IHSS recipients. Upon request, the Public Authority will send a recipient a list of care providers. The **Public Authority also offers**

training opportunities for care providers.

PUBLIC GUARDIAN

- Provides mandated conservatorship services to older and dependent adults who are no longer able to act in their own best interest, resist undue influence, or are gravely disabled as a result of a psychiatric or cognitive disorder.
- Ave. 72 clients per month

VETERANS SERVICES

 Provides assistance to veterans and their dependents to help them obtain Federal benefits, including: compensation for service connected disabilities, pensions for certain lowincome veterans, medical care, spousal benefits, tuition

fee waivers for eligible dependents, and other services.
