

Road Closures on July 16, 2022

Due to the **WineShine Half Marathon**, road closures will be necessary on portions of Atlas Peak Rd, Monticello Rd, Silverado Trail, and Hardman Ave for a period of time. The following times are <u>approximate</u> and may be used as general guidelines.

Atlas Peak Rd from Hardman Ave to Monticello Rd	6:55 to 7:20am
Monticello Rd from Atlas Peak Rd to Silverado Trail (SB lane detour)	7:00 to 7:40am
Silverado Trail from Trancas St to Hardman Ave	7:10 to 8:00am
Silverado Trail from Hardman Ave to Wapoo Hill Rd	7:15 to 10:15am
Hardman Ave from Silverado Trail to Atlas Peak Rd	8:00 to 10:30am

Traffic controls and closures will be controlled by CHP; all times and closures are subject to change at CHP's discretion.

Southbound Monticello Rd traffic will be detoured using Vichy Ave and Hagen Rd during the impact time. The northbound lane of Silverado Trail between Trancas St and Wapoo Hill Rd will be closed to all traffic during this time. Northbound through traffic should use Hwy 29 during the event time. CHP will lead escorted local traffic for residents and workers in the southbound lane during the event. Winery workers needing access during the impact times can request a worker permit. The accompanying 3.9 mile race will run a counter-clockwise loop around Silverado Resort on Atlas Peak Rd, Hillcrest Dr, and Westgate Dr. Runners will run against traffic in the bike lane/shoulder and roads will remain open to vehicles.
