## AMENDMENT NO. 1 NAPA COUNTY AGREEMENT NO. 200152B

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO AGREEMENT NO. 200152B is effective as of this \_\_\_\_\_\_ day of\_\_\_\_\_\_, 2022, by and between NAPA COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY," and THE SALVATION ARMY, a California non-profit religious corporation, whose business address is 3048 Hawthorne Boulevard, Rancho Palos Verdes, CA 90275, hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR."

## **RECITALS**

**WHEREAS**, COUNTY wishes to obtain specialized services, as authorized by Government Code section 31000, in order to provide a daily meal for the residents of the Napa County Homeless Shelter; and

**WHEREAS**, CONTRACTOR is willing to provide such specialized services to COUNTY under the terms and conditions set forth herein.

**WHEREAS**, the parties wish to adjust the compensation and amend the terms of the Agreement accordingly.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR hereby amend the Agreement in the manner set forth below.

## TERMS

1) Paragraph 3 of the Agreement, entitled "Compensation" is amended to read in full as follows:

## "Compensation.

(a) <u>Rates.</u> In consideration of CONTRACTOR's fulfillment of the promised work, COUNTY shall pay CONTRACTOR at the rate of EIGHT DOLLARS (\$8.00) per meal provided.

(b) <u>Expenses.</u> No travel or other expenses will be reimbursed by COUNTY.

(c) <u>Maximum Amount.</u> Notwithstanding subparagraphs (a) and (b), the maximum payments under this Agreement shall be a total of ONE HUNDERD THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000) for professional services per fiscal year; provided, however, that such amounts shall not be construed as guaranteed sums, and compensation shall be based upon services actually rendered and reimbursable expenses actually incurred."

2) All other terms and conditions of the Agreement, except as amended herein, shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
