## **BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION**

Napa Valley water managers have retained hydrologists, environmental scientists and engineers to study future water demands, analyze local water resource yields and imported supplies and identify reservoir storage expansion opportunities. Reports such as Urban Water Management Plans, Water Shortage Contingency Plans, Napa Valley Drought Contingency Plan and system specific Master Plans publish content related to reservoir capacity.
