EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Director of Library Services and Community Outreach is reporting that the Library received \$2,835 in multiple donations during the fourth quarter of fiscal year 2020-2021. The donations were accepted by the Director in accordance with Resolution 99-56 and deposited within the Library Fund.
