**RESOLUTION OF THE NAPA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS,
STATE OF CALIFORNIA, PROCLAIMING THE TERMINATION OF THE
STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY DUE TO PERVASIVE TREE
MORTALITY**

WHEREAS, Government Code section 8630 authorizes local governing bodies to proclaim local emergencies when such events occur as are described in California Government Code section 8558(c)(1); and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 8630 further provides that the local governing body review the need for continuing the local emergency at least once every 60 days until the governing body terminates the local emergency; and

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2022, the Board of Supervisors proclaimed a state of local emergency due to pervasive tree mortality in Napa County, pursuant to Resolution No. 2022-132, and has regularly reviewed and continued the state of local emergency since then; and

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2026, the Governor proclaimed that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property due to tree mortality no longer exist and terminated California's state of emergency due to tree mortality effective immediately; and

WHEREAS, conditions have improved significantly in Napa County since the Board proclaimed a state of local emergency in 2022, with a December 2024 Summary Report released by the US Forest Service indicating that of over 1 million acres of affected forest in California, only 200 acres are in Napa County; and

WHEREAS, Napa County is not currently engaged in any activities or pursuing any funding that relies on the state of local emergency due to tree mortality; and

WHEREAS, while the impact of drought and bark beetles on trees in Napa County may always be a concern, existing conditions no longer rise to the level of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property as stated in Government Code section 8558(c); and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 8630 requires the governing body of a local agency to proclaim the termination of a state of local emergency once conditions warrant the end of the emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Napa County Board of Supervisors, that pursuant to Government Code section 8630 the state of local emergency due to pervasive tree mortality in Napa County is hereby terminated.
