**RESOLUTION OF THE NAPA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS,
STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO AND
PARTICIPATION IN THE CALIFORNIA HEALTH AND HUMAN
SERVICES DATA EXCHANGE FRAMEWORK: SINGLE DATA
SHARING AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, California Health and Safety Code § 130290 was enacted in 2021 and establishes the creation of the California Health and Human Services Data Exchange Framework and requires certain data sharing among entities as set forth in California Health and Safety Code § 130290(f) on or before January 31, 2026. California Health and Safety Code § 130290 also provides for the California Health and Human Services Agency to encourage the inclusion of county health, public benefit, and social services as part of the Data Exchange Framework.

WHEREAS, the Data Exchange Framework will be governed by the single data sharing agreement and common set of policies and procedures that require the exchange of certain health information among health care entities and government entities within California.

WHEREAS, Napa County Health and Human Services Agency is authorized to enter into the Data Exchange Framework pursuant to California Health and Safety code section 130290 for the agency as a whole or for specific divisions of the agency.

WHEREAS, Napa County Health and Human Services Agency, desires to enter into the single data sharing agreement with the California Health and Human Services Agency (CalHHS) Center for Data Insights and Innovation initially as to the Napa County Behavioral Health Division only because the Behavioral Health Division has the infrastructure to electronically exchange data through the California Mental Health Services Authority (CalMHSA) electronic platforms.

WHEREAS, Napa County Health and Human Services Agency desires to add other agency divisions to the Data Exchange Framework as the divisions become ready to electronically exchange data through available electronic platforms;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Napa County Board of Supervisors as follows:

1. **Jennifer Yasumoto, Director of Health and Human Services Agency**, (the "**Authorized Signatory**"), is authorized to execute and submit the CalHHS Data Sharing Agreement (DSA) (Attachment "A") via the signing portal provided by the California Health and Human Services Agency as to the Napa County Behavioral Health Services Division.
2. **Jennifer Yasumoto, Director of Health and Human Services Agency**, (the "**Authorized Signatory**"), is authorized to amend and execute the CalHHS Data Sharing Agreement (DSA) (Attachment "A") via the signing portal provided by the California Health and Human Services Agency to add additional HHS divisions or the agency as a whole as the divisions develop the infrastructure to adhere to the policies and procedures contained in the DSA and to utilize a central electronic data sharing system.
