## AMENDMENT NO. 1

# NAPA COUNTY AGREEMENT NO. 230231B PURCHASE AND SALE AGREEMENT

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 1 OF NAPA COUNTY AGREEMENT NO. 230231B is made and entered into as of this <u>28</u> day of <u>Jure</u>, 2023, by and between SHAI SHEFER, A MARRIED MAN AS HIS SOLE AND SEPARATE PROPERTY AND GIL SHEFER, AN UNMARRIED MAN AS JOINT TENANTS (hereinafter referred to as "GRANTOR") and NAPA COUNTY, A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA (hereinafter referred to as "GRANTEE"). The GRANTOR and GRANTEE may be referred to below collectively as "Parties" and individually as "Party."

## RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into Napa County Agreement No. 230231B with GRANTEE on November 8, 2022 (the "Agreement"), in order for the GRANTEE to purchase Assessor's Parcel Number 027-330-002 from the GRANTOR for the Dry Creek Road Bridge over Dry Creek Replacement Project, RDS 15-22; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions set forth in the Agreement, the GRANTOR has been paid in full by GRANTEE for the fee simple granted to GRANTEE and the Grant Deed has been recorded by GRANTEE; and

WHEREAS, after entering into the Agreement, the parties recognized that Caltransmandated language regarding the parties' commitment to compliance with the provisions of Title VI of The Civil Rights Act of 1964 that was inadvertently omitted from the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to amend the Agreement to introduce the inadvertently omitted Civil Rights Act commitment;

### **TERMS**

**NOW, THEREFORE,** for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which are hereby acknowledged, GRANTEE and GRANTOR hereby amend the Agreement as follows:

1. Paragraph 27 is added to the Agreement as follows:

### 27. Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

The parties to this Agreement shall, pursuant to Section 21.7(a) of Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, comply with all elements of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. This requirement under Title VI and the Code of Federal Regulations is to complete the USDOT Non-Discrimination Assurance requiring compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 49 C.F.R. Parts 21 and 28 C.F.R.

Further, no person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, be PL No. 91573

excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity that is the subject of this Agreement.

2. Except as provided in (1) above, all other provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect as previously approved and amended.
