

Subject: Introduction of Reusable and Compostable Foodware Ordinance

Dear Napa County Business / Food Purveyor:

We all value Napa County's beautiful landscapes and waterways, and we share a responsibility to protect the environment for future generations.

Napa County is considering a new ordinance to promote sustainability by reducing single-use foodware. This initiative would require businesses to switch to reusable or compostable foodware.

By adopting this ordinance, Napa County aims to reduce these negative impacts and move towards a more sustainable future.
