#### NAPA COUNTY AGREEMENT NO. 240019B

#### AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO GRANT AGREEMENT

#### THIS AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO NAPA COUNTY GRANT AGREEMENT NO.

240019B is made and entered into as of this 1st day of July, 2024, by and between the COUNTY OF NAPA, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY," and LUCKY PENNY PRODUCTIONS, a California non-profit corporation whose mailing address is 1357 Foster Road, Napa, CA, 94558 hereinafter referred to as "GRANTEE."

## **RECITALS**

**WHEREAS**, in July, 2023, COUNTY approved funding for GRANTEE's proposal for Special Project Funds to replace existing incandescent stage lighting in the theatre space with new LED stage lighting, and

WHEREAS, as a result of scheduling and delays in construction, the project was not completed within the time frame expected and set forth in the Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, COUNTY and GRANTEE now wish to extend the term of this Grant Agreement to allow GRANTEE additional time to complete the project as originally approved by COUNTY.

#### **TERMS**

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT AGREED that County Grant Agreement No. 240019B is hereby amended as follows:

- 1. Exhibit "A" of the Agreement is rescinded and replaced in full by that document entitled Exhibit "A-1", and all references in the Agreement to Exhibit "A" shall mean Exhibit "A-1".
- 2. Exhibit "B" of the Agreement is rescinded and replaced in full by that document entitled Exhibit "B-1", and all references in the Agreement to Exhibit "B" shall mean Exhibit "B-1".
- 3. Paragraph 1 of the Agreement is amended to read in full as follows:

## 1. Term of the Agreement/Termination.

- (a) <u>Term.</u> The term of this Agreement shall commence on June 30, 2024 and shall expire on December 31, 2024, unless terminated earlier in accordance with subparagraph 1(b), except that the obligations of GRANTEE under Paragraph 3 (Use of Grant Funds), Paragraph 4 (Return of Funds), Paragraph 5 (Reporting), and Paragraph 6 (Maintenance, Inspection, and Retention of Records) shall survive the expiration or early termination date, and Paragraphs 10 (Liability) and 11 (Indemnification) shall continue in full force and effect after said expiration or early termination date as to any liability for acts and omissions occurring during the term of this Agreement."
  - 4. Except as provided in Paragraph 1 above, the remaining terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
