

SECOND AMENDMENT TO NAPA COUNTY AGREEMENT NO. 220022B

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 220022B is made and entered into in Napa County, California, this 5th day of May, 2026, by and between Napa County, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as “County,” and Charles Johnson, doing business as CJ’s Police K-9’s, whose business address is 402 Indian Springs, Novato, CA 94947, hereinafter referred to as “CONTRACTOR.”

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2021, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR executed Napa County Agreement No. 220022B, (the Agreement) for specialized services, as authorized by Government Code section 31000, in order to provide K-9 and K-9 handler related services; and

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2024, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR executed Amendment No. 1 to the extend the term and adjust the compensation rates; and

WHEREAS, the parties would now like to amend the Agreement to increase the maximum compensation.

TERMS

NOW, THEREFORE, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR hereby agree to amend the Agreement in the manner as set forth below.

1. Section 3 of the Agreement, Compensation, is amended to read in full as follows:

“Compensation.

(a) Rates. In consideration of CONTRACTOR's fulfillment of the promised work, COUNTY shall pay CONTRACTOR at the rates set forth in Exhibit “B-2,” attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein.


(b) Expenses. No travel or other expenses will be reimbursed by COUNTY.

(c) Maximum Amount. Notwithstanding subparagraphs (a) and (b), the maximum payments under this Agreement shall be a total of EIGHTY- FIVE THOUSAND dollars (\$85,000) for professional services per fiscal year; provided, however, that such amounts shall not be construed as guaranteed sums, and compensation shall be based upon services actually rendered and reimbursable expenses actually incurred.

2. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement, except as amended herein, shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
