Exhibit A- Research Project Description (Revised March 2, 2026)

This Research Project Description is issued under the Data Use Agreement (the “Agreement”) between Data Owner and The Regents of the University of California, on behalf of the California Policy Lab at its UCLA and UC Berkeley campuses (“CPL”), with an effective date August 22, 2023.

Together with the Agreement, this Research Project Description governs the conduct of the research contemplated herein.

1. Project Title: AB 372 Domestic Violence Pilot Evaluation
2. Year-Number: 2023-1 (*Revised March 2, 2026*)
3. Description of the research (“Research”):

The purpose of this project is to draw on local and state data criminal justice to evaluate the effects of California’s AB 372 Domestic Violence Pilot on probationer outcomes. To accomplish this goal, we will identify individuals who were “treated” by the AB 372 Pilot – those in pilot study counties who received sentences that made them eligible for the county to use greater flexibility in setting programming requirements. In addition to local outcomes data, we will link local data to state criminal history data to explore the statewide recidivism outcomes for these individuals. We will then compare the outcomes for the treated to those of similar individuals who were sentenced and served probation terms in the period prior to the pilot. Finally, to address the possibility of broader changes in recidivism trends over the time period, we will identify comparison pre-post cohort of individuals sentenced for different offense types and assess the change in recidivism outcomes for the pilot cohort relative to a comparison cohort.

The research team will produce a report that summarizes the key findings from this study. CPL plans to publish and distribute this report, making the findings available to California policymakers and practitioners.

4. Description of data to be provided (“Data”):

Data Owner will include event level probation files with individual-level identifiers for the period 2016-2023.
