

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-39

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AMERICAN CANYON
CALLING AND GIVING NOTICE OF A MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2026,
REQUESTING CONSOLIDATION OF SAID ELECTION WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION,
AND REQUESTING ELECTION SERVICES FROM THE COUNTY OF NAPA**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the laws of the State of California relating to general law cities and the American Canyon Municipal Code, a Municipal Election is required to be held on November 3, 2026, for the election of certain municipal officers; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of American Canyon desires to call and give notice of said Municipal Election pursuant to the California Elections Code; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the Municipal Election be consolidated with the Statewide General Election to be held on November 3, 2026, and that within the City of American Canyon the precincts, vote centers, polling places, election officers, and election procedures be the same; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires that the Napa County Elections Division canvass the returns of the Municipal Election and that the election be conducted in all respects as though there were only one election.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AMERICAN CANYON DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Election Called.

Pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of California relating to general law cities, a Municipal Election is hereby called and ordered to be held in the City of American Canyon on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, for the purpose of electing two (2) members of the City Council for full four-year terms.

Section 2. Ballots.

The ballots to be used at the election shall be in the form and content required by law.

Section 3. Request for Election Services.

Pursuant to Elections Code section 10002, the City Council hereby requests that the Napa County Board of Supervisors authorize the Napa County Elections Official to provide election services to the City of American Canyon for the consolidated election, including but not limited to the following:

- a) Provide vote centers, polling places, ballot drop boxes, and election officers, and establish compensation for such services;
- b) Provide for the receipt, processing, and counting of vote-by-mail ballots;
- c) Furnish precinct supplies, indices, training, and related election materials and services;
- d) Procure and furnish official ballots, notices, printed matter, equipment, and all supplies necessary to lawfully conduct the election;
- e) Conduct the central counting of ballots, count write-in votes, and conduct the official canvass of the election returns;
- f) Certify the results and provide all required post-election services and materials;

- g) Perform all other services and take all actions necessary for the conduct of the election as may be requested by the City; and
- h) Provide the City with an itemized invoice for services provided.

Section 4. Notice of Election.

Notice of the time and place of holding the election is hereby given, and the City Clerk is authorized, instructed, and directed to give further or additional notice of the election in the time, form, and manner required by law.

Section 5. Request for Consolidation.

Pursuant to Elections Code section 10403, the Napa County Board of Supervisors is hereby requested to consent and agree to the consolidation of the City of American Canyon Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election to be held on November 3, 2026.

Section 6. Canvass and Conduct of Election.

The Napa County Elections Division is authorized to canvass the returns of the election. The election shall be held and conducted in all respects as if there were only one election, and only one form of ballot shall be used. The election shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of law regulating the Statewide General Election.

Section 7. Reimbursement of Costs.

The City of American Canyon recognizes that additional costs will be incurred by the County of Napa by reason of this consolidation and agrees to reimburse the County for all costs related to the election services provided that are not otherwise reimbursed by the State of California.

Section 8. Filing of Resolution.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Resolution with the Napa County Board of Supervisors and the Napa County Elections Division.

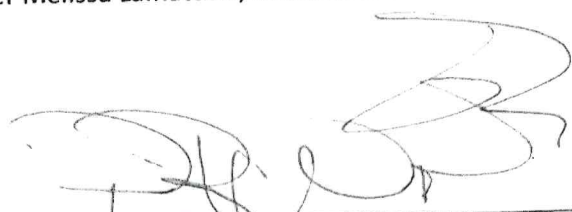
