## RESOLUTION OF THE NAPA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DIRECTING THE CHIEF HUMAN RESOURCES OFFICER TO INITIATE A CONTRACT AMENDMENT TO IMPLEMENT RETIREMENT COST SHARING CONTRIBUTIONS CHANGES FOR NAPA COUNTY EMPLOYEES EFFECTIVE JULY 22, 2025.

**WHEREAS,** the Public Employees' Retirement Law permits the participation of public agencies and their employees in the California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS) by execution of contract; and

**WHEREAS,** Napa County reached agreement with the Napa Association of Public Employees that any decrease in the retirement contribution rates will reduce both the Public Services Employee and Public Services Employee Supervisory bargaining units cost share up to a maximum of 0.5%.

**WHEREAS,** unrepresented Management and unrepresented Confidential employees, through their respective Management Compensation Plans, receive the same benefits afforded in accordance with the current Memoranda of Understanding between the County and the Supervisory Public Services Employee Unit; and

WHEREAS, the unrepresented Management Safety employees, through their respective Management Compensation Plans, receive the same benefits afforded in accordance with the current Memoranda of Understanding between the County and the Supervisory Public Services Employee Unit; and

WHEREAS, Napa County obtained simple majority of signatures from unrepresented Management Miscellaneous, unrepresented Confidential Miscellaneous, and unrepresented Management Safety employees to agree to a change in the cost sharing agreement which requires a contract amendment with CalPERS, and an ordinance change to implement any cost sharing rate changes; and

**WHEREAS**, the unrepresented Management Miscellaneous and unrepresented Confidential Miscellaneous employees shall participate in the new cost sharing pursuant to Government Code Section 20516 effective the beginning of a pay period following a formalized employee vote and final adoption of a new ordinance:
